

Seven of them, however, were not included in the complete series. Three - The Boon of Bohn, published in February, 1887, Greit for Greek, and The Student and his Bow-wow, were contributed to Alma Mater; and four - In the Quad, The Weary Student, On a Mantle-shelf, and By Torchlight, to other periodicals. They have all been subjected to revision, and some notes, which it is hoped are not superfluous, have been added.
