Each State is entitled to have two Cadets from the State at large, and thirty are appointed from the United States at large. The appointment from a Congressional District is made upon the recommendation of the Congressman from that District, and those from a State at large upon the recommendations of the Senators of the State. Similarly the appointment from a Territory is made upon the recommendation of the Delegate in Congress.
